## Monthly Overview

The goal this month is to help children understand that each person has his or her own abilities and strengths. We should celebrate our differences and learn about one another. Children will need guidance to understand how to treat those who may act or do things differently from them. In turn, the children will learn what loyalty means and how being loyal to one another despite our differences and similarities is important in being a valuable member of their class and community.

- **Acceptance:** treating everyone with respect and understanding regardless of differences; understanding how we are alike and different.
- **Forgiveness:** the act of letting go of negative feelings toward a person who has caused hurt or harm.
- **Loyalty:** feeling of devotion or faithfulness toward family members, friends, country, or a cause in which we believe.
- **Teamwork:** working together with other people to get to the same result.  
Family Home Extension: Acceptance
- As a family, talk about the different things each family member likes to do. Schedule time to participate in activities that meet the interests of each family member. For example, if someone likes animals, take a trip to a zoo or local animal shelter. Discuss how it is important to support and accept one another's interests.  
Family Home Extension
- Toddlers often have trouble expressing themselves when they feel big emotions such as anger or frustration. Reinforce that it is inappropriate to hit, bite, or kick, for example. Help children develop self-soothing strategies such as breathing (or blowing), squeezing a squishy ball or hugging a stuffed animal, or throwing or kicking a ball. Always be quick to forgive a child who acts out in frustration.
- Children learn how to be a friend by being exposed to situations where they can build relationships with others. Expose children to playdates, themed Family and Me classes, park days, and family gatherings. These social situations will provide wonderful opportunities for children to develop the skills needed to get along with others.

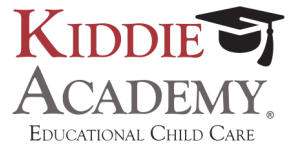
