During the month of April, Kiddie Academy helps children learn honesty through our monthly theme of "We are good citizens." Teaching children honesty can be difficult because of the examples of dishonesty they could, and most likely will, encounter, but the key is to make them feel good about telling the truth.

The reasons children lie depend on their age. Younger children do not understand the difference between the real world and make believe. They often lie to test boundaries and ensure their security. What may be perceived as lies with older children, may in fact be a variation of their perception of the truth.

Here are some ways you can help teach your children the importance of honesty at home:

-Curb your own white lies. Lead by example. Telling your children "white lies" sets an example of dishonesty.

-Find examples in books. Reading stories, such as Tales of Peter Rabbit by Beatrix Potter or Believing Sophie by Hazel Hutchins will give you a chance to talk about what it means to be honest. Books are also a good way to help children distinguish between what's real and make-believe.

-Play the Truth Game. Gather the family to play this "truth only" version of a truth or dare game by allowing each family member to talk about their feelings. For example, "How do thunderstorms make you feel?" or "I was scared when..." By talking about how they feel through this game, children can learn to feel safe about telling the truth. And kids learn values, such as honesty, from watching and listening to their parents.

-Give Praise. Praise your child when she does tell the truth, particularly when she has lied in the past; this boosts self-confidence and encourages positive behavior.

-Teach them the Truth is Okay. Children often lie out of fear of the consequences, expecting bad things to happen as punishment. Once the child acknowledges the lie, pose the question, "How can we make this right?" It gives them the ability to right their wrong and see there's nothing scary about telling the truth.
